Genesis of Pratapgarh

The city of Pratapgarh was established by Raja Pratap Bahadur (1628-1682) and the city in and around his fort/garh was known as Pratapgarh after his name at that time.

Climate and Population with area

The month of September has been observed to be the best time to visit Pratapgarh City as the season remains pretty nice. The temperature ranges between 77°F and 99°F and the humidity of 79% where you can check out the best things and make a memorable experience without having to worry about small issues, however, it may rain occasionally for a very short period. Population of Pratapgarh is around 36,20,910 and the area of Pratapgarh district is 3,717 km.



Places of Interest to Be Visited



1. Bhakti Dham Temple of Radhey Krishna :

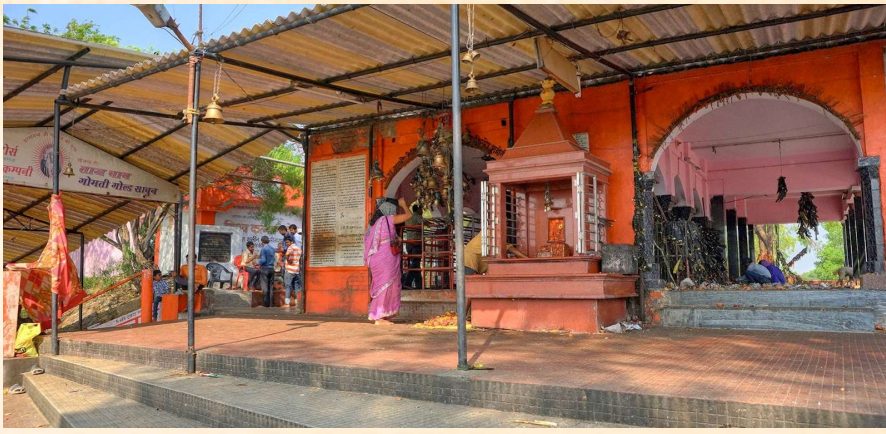
This temple is situated in the Mangarh, Kunda tehsil of Pratapgarh, foundation of which was laid down by world famous Jagadguru Shri Kripaluji Maharaj. His other temples are in Vrindavan (Prem Mandir) and Barsana (Kirti Mandir) near Mathura. One of the evenings we shall take you to see the

glory of this temple in Mangarh (Bhakti Dham) which is marvellous and we shall have a glimpse of Bhakti and we shall also have dinner there.

2. Belha Devi Temple :

Pratapgarh is a district often called as Behla Pratapgarh as there is a Shakti Peeth of Maa Sati Parvati whose waist part (Behla) was dropped by Lord Shiva at this place. This temple is situated at the bank of river Sai where Lord Rama also worshipped Maa Sati at this very Behla Mandir when Lord Rama was proceeding to Chitrakoot for his vanwas accepting the verdict of kaikeyi. It is very famous for the fulfilment of your desire.





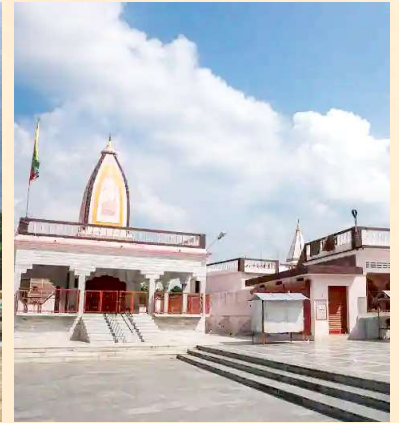
3. Shani Dev Temple :

Shani Dev Dham, the temple dedicated to Shani Dev, is located at a distance of about 51 km from Allahabad, 16 km from Pratapgarh, 116 km from Ayodhya, & 3 km from Vishwanathganj in Kushfara village. Hanuman and Manokamana temples are also situated in the same premises. Every Saturday people throng in large

numbers & perform special worship here. Navratri is also celebrated here.

4. Other Religious Temple :

Other religious temples are "Maa Panchmukhee Temple, Kisaan Devta Mandir, Bhayharan Nath Dhaam, Ghuisarnath or Ghusmeshvar Dhaam, Chandrika Devi shaktipeeth, Haudeshwar Nath Mandir, Shakti Maa Chauharan Dhaam, and other several temples.

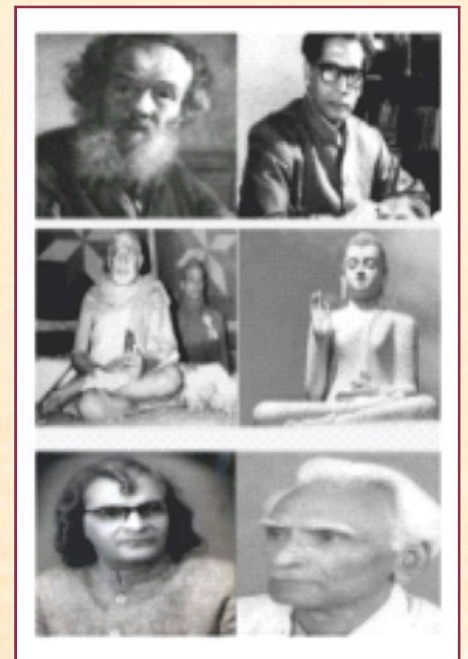


5. Bagh of Amla

Pratapgarh district is the largest producer of Amla in the state of Uttar Pradesh. Therefore, Pratapgarh is often known as Amla Nagri.

6. Celebrities of Pratapgarh :

1. This is the birth place of famous poet Hari Vansh Rai Bachchan who is the father of most famous actor Amitabh Bachchan.
2. It is also a birth place of our great poet of Reeti kaal kavi acharya Bhikhari Das as well as of Dharma Emperor Swami Karpatriji.
3. It has been Taposthali of Mahatma Buddha.
4. Famous Poet Sumitra Nandan Panth, Chayavaadi Kavi wrote several books during his stay at Pratapgarh for a period of ten years.
5. Aaadhya Prasad Unmat was one of the most famous Literary personality and is a poet who was born in Malhupur village of Pratapgarh District.

Material & Methods, Observation, Results & Conclusion.

A camera-ready abstract in English in A4 size page strictly in prescribed format should be submitted online along with registration form latest by 20th July 2022 via E-mail to asmcpbhheadbiochem@gmail.com.

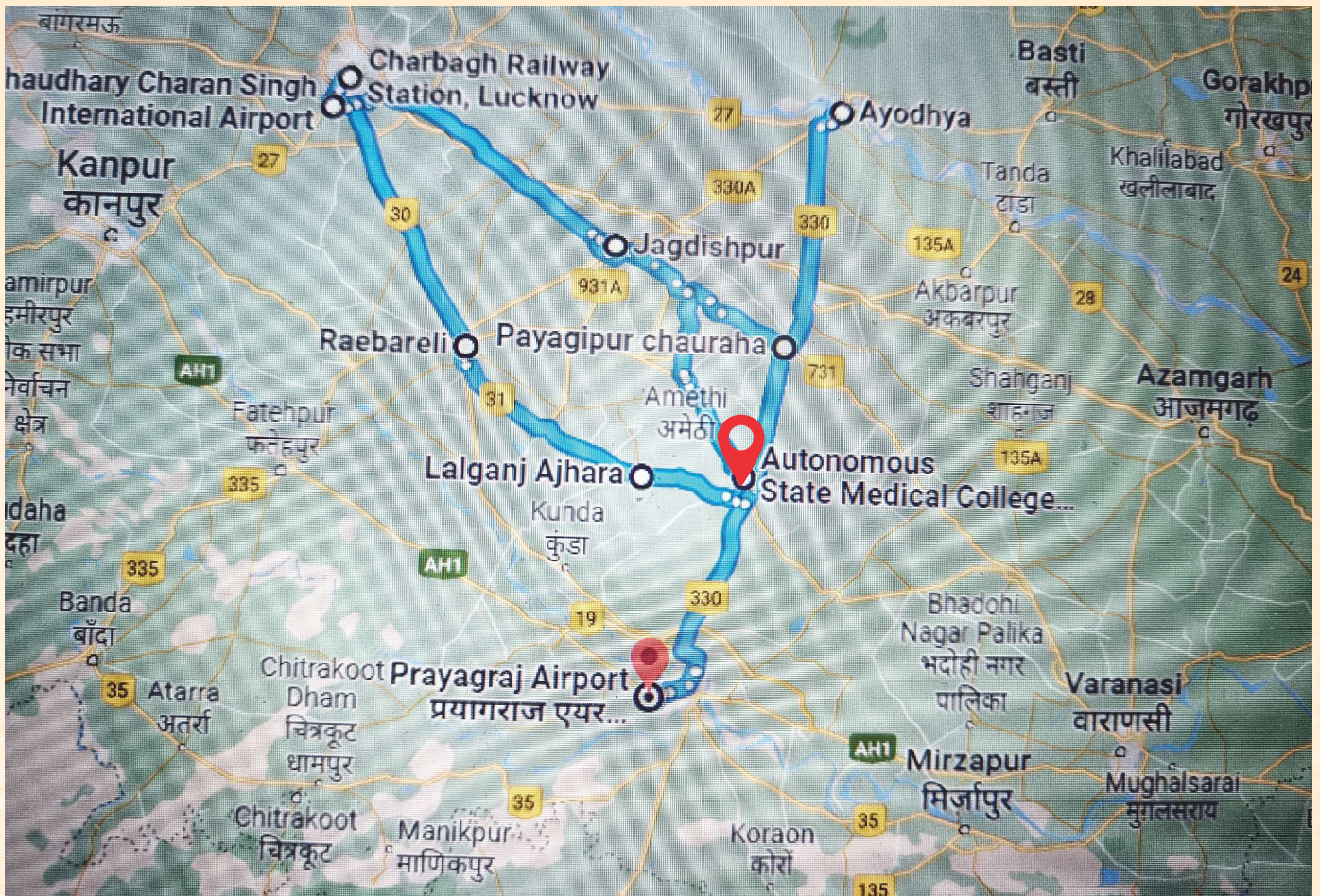
